## Past and present 过去与现在

Chinese characters have a long history. They gradually evolved from symbols that look like drawings to today's square-shaped characters. Look and compare the scripts below.

Oracle bone script, dated from 1300 BC, is believed to be the earliest form of Chinese writing.



Today, people in mainland China use these simplified Chinese characters.



Look at how Chinese characters have evolved. Can you guess what the four characters mean?

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
Today, the simplified Chinese characters are mainly used in mainland China. The traditional Chinese characters are used in some other countries and regions.

**Pictograms** take on the shape of objects. **Ideograms** are simple signs. They depict abstract meanings.



Ideogrammatic compounds combine two or more existing characters to express new meanings.

**Semantic-phonetic** compounds are made up of two parts. One indicates the meaning of the character. The other indicates the sound.



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
