**Reading 5** Sequencing events, items and pictures

**Learning point**  
When we sequence events, items and pictures, we put them in the correct order. Keywords such as **first**, **next**, **then**, **before**, **after** and **finally** in the text help us work out the answers. We can use 'next', 'then' and 'after that' in any order.

(e.g.) **First**, get two slices of bread, a jar of jam and a knife ready. **Next**, spread the jam on one slice of bread. **Then**, put the other slice of bread on top. **Finally**, cut the sandwich in half.

Arrange the steps of making a jam sandwich in the correct order.  
A B C D   
C → A → D → B

The keywords **first**, **next**, **then** and **finally** in the above passage show the steps of making a jam sandwich.




## Writing support


