- 20 have stored back into the atmosphere once they are cut down. To cut a long story short, the livestock industry and global warming are closely connected.





3 Likewise, we ourselves are also suffering from a meatbased diet. Research has confirmed that high consumption of red meat is linked to a greater risk of heart disease. This is the number one cause of death in many countries around the world. Another unsettling health concern is that these animals are often treated with steroid hormones to 30 increase their growth rates. Antibiotics are also given regularly to protect them from insanitary living conditions or to prevent the adverse effects of hormone treatments. Humans, in turn, ingest these chemicals. Scientists believe these chemicals may lead to other serious illnesses such as 35 cancer and dementia in the long term.



The United Nations warns that 'livestock's contribution to environmental problems is on a massive scale'. It also states that the issue 'needs to be addressed with urgency'. According to the Union of Concerned Scientists, meat-eating is the second-most pressing environmental problem. It comes after fossil fuel vehicles. As far as cost, health and morals are concerned, there is no benefit—besides possibly taste—to eating meat. Our environment is on the brink of



disaster. There is no longer time to delay. In recent years, natural disasters such as superstorms, floods and droughts have become more frequent and severe because of climate change. If having a little less meat can help save the planet and improve our health at the same time, it is undeniably worth our effort.
