① As part of my degree's coursework, I am doing a presentation on gaming addiction next month. Check out these chilling stories.



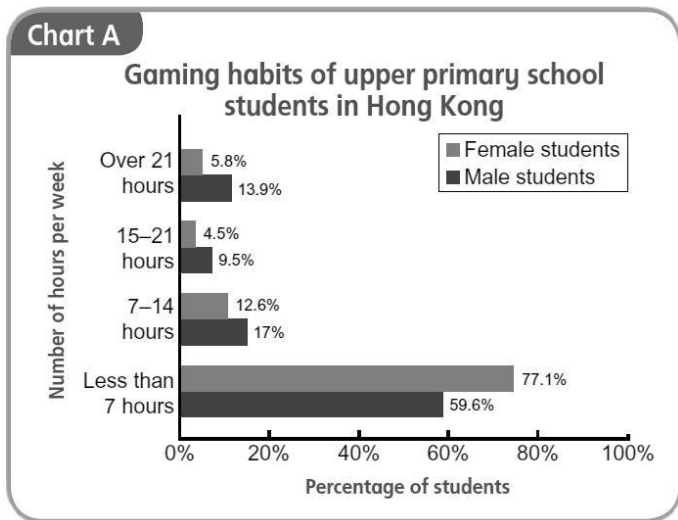
② It is estimated that more than three million Americans between the ages of 8 and 18 are addicted to video games.
5 A former gaming addict named Brett was downhearted when his parents cut him off from his favourite game *Counter-Strike*. He recalls having very dark thoughts after that. Luckily, his parents intervened. He was eventually rehabilitated. Elsewhere in the country, another teen
10 named Daniel turned a firearm on his parents. This was all because they refused to let him play the violent video game *Halo 3*.

③ Then there is the tragic story of a three-month old South Korean baby girl. She died because her parents were hooked
15 on *PRIUS*, a life simulation video game. Ironically, the couple's digital avatars were also married with a baby—the digital infant was in excellent health. In China, 24-year-old Wu Tai dropped dead after playing *World of Warcraft* for 19 hours without a break.

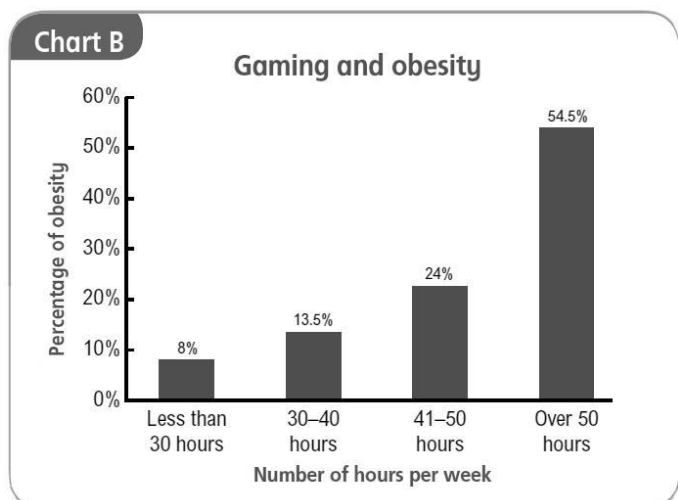

- 20 ④ A survey by the University of Hong Kong has found that nearly one in ten upper primary school students were addicted to gaming or at risk of gaming addiction in Hong Kong. The problem was more prevalent among boys. They spent an average of 11 hours per week on gaming. Meanwhile, girls only spent an average of 5.7 hours per week.
- 25 Psychologists warned that gaming addiction can lead to problems like obesity and poor eyesight. Gaming addicts might also experience difficulty in social interactions offline.
