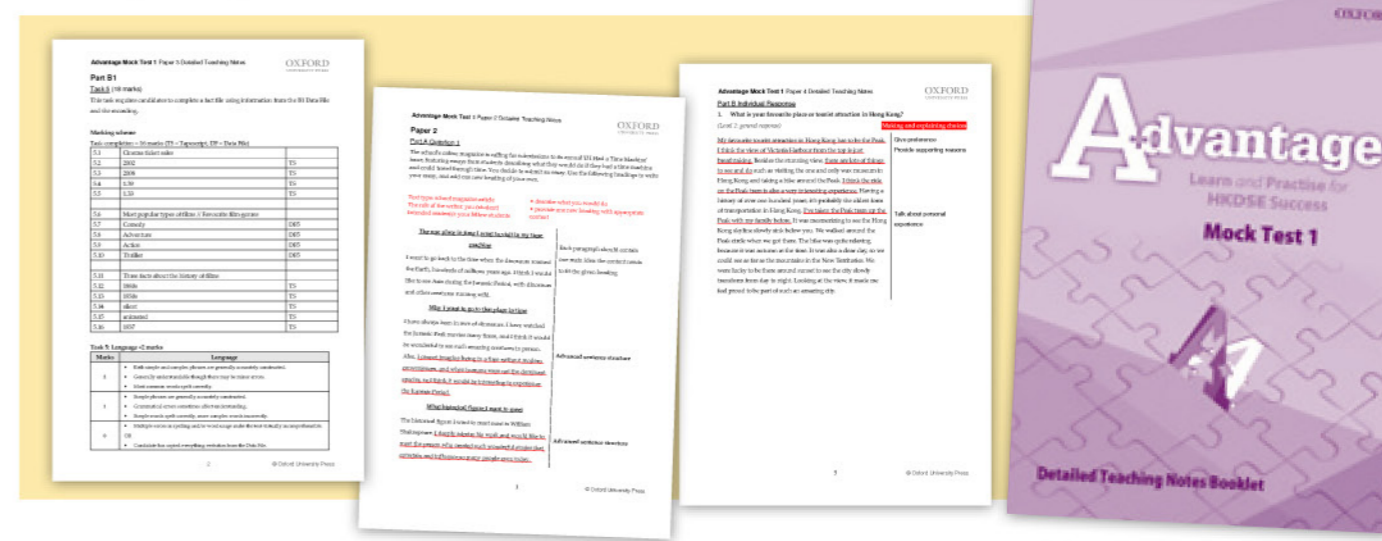
HKDSE mock tests for Secondary 4

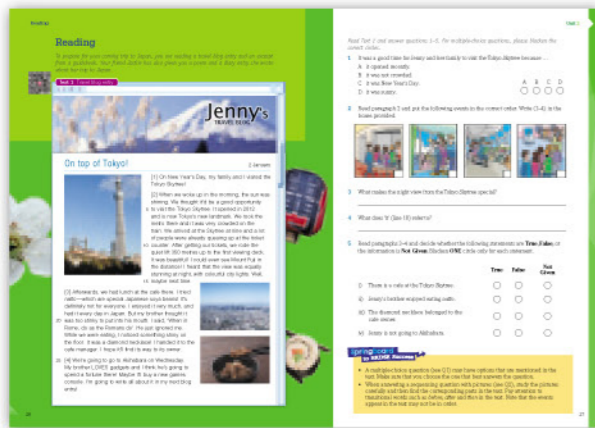


Each mock test comes with very detailed teaching notes, the latest HKDSE Paper 3 marking schemes, as well as annotated model writing for Papers 2 and 4.

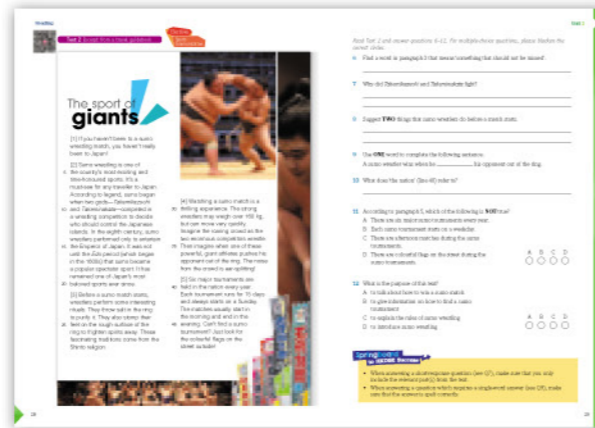


Engaging reading texts and HKDSE-style comprehension

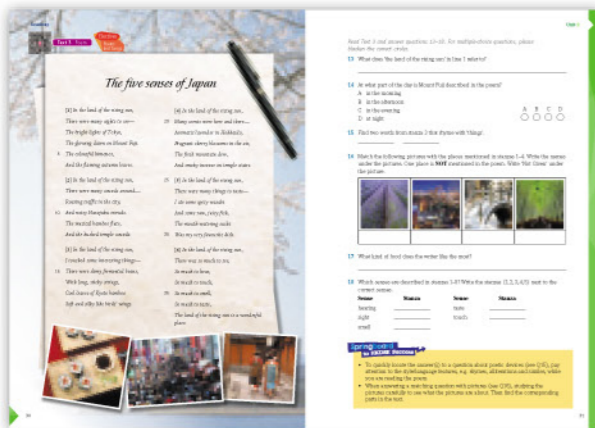

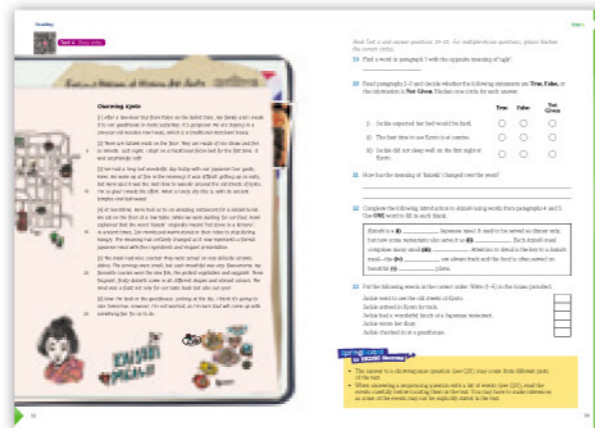

Wide exposure to text types

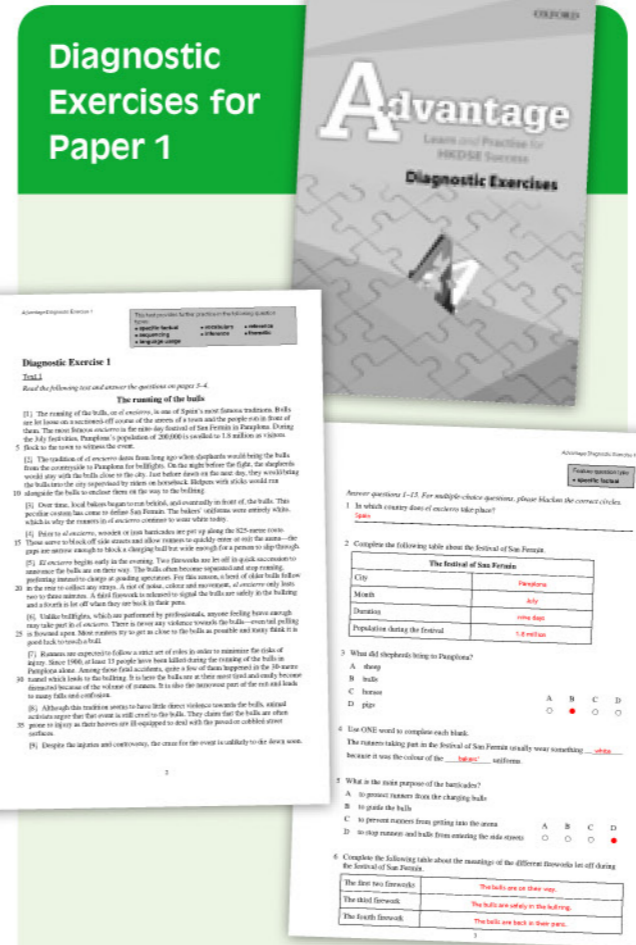
All the text types that are commonly seen in the HKDSE English exam are featured in *Advantage*, including:

- travel guidebook article



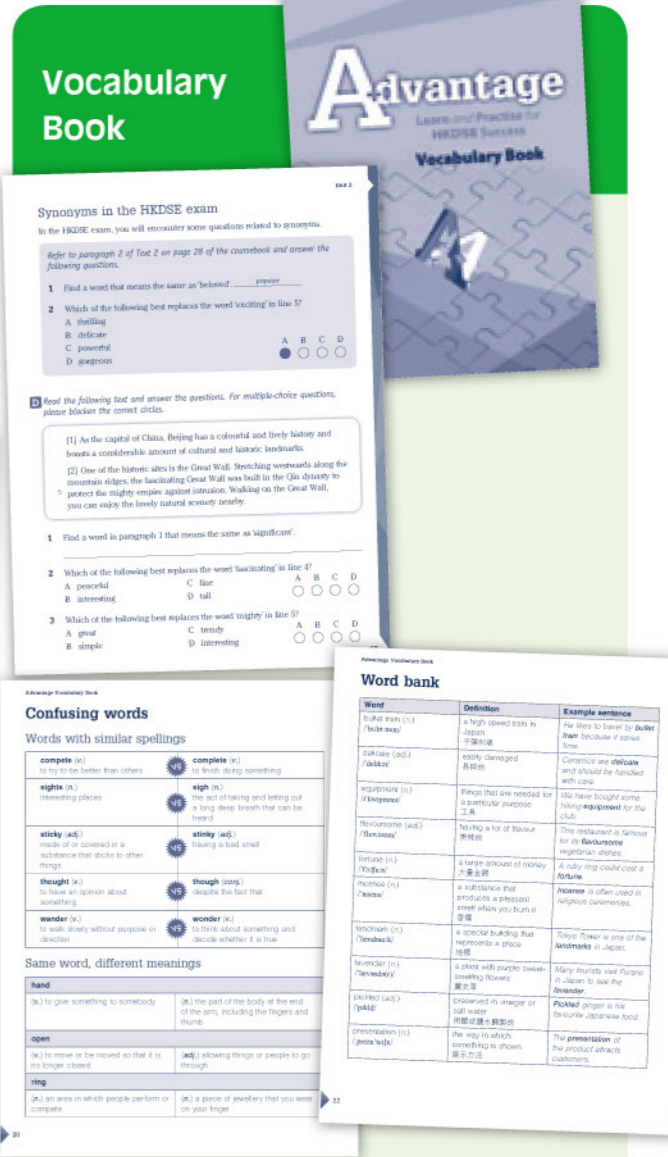
Total HKDSE support
