The impact of COVID-19 on our health

Since the **coronavirus pandemic** swept across the world in 2020, there has been a much greater emphasis in society on public health. However, many serious health problems were forced to take a back seat to the coronavirus pandemic. As a result, many of those problems have actually got worse. Let's look at some of them.



Type 2 diabetes is a chronic health condition which affects how your body turns food into energy. Obesity and being overweight are the biggest risk factors for developing diabetes, so it is a big problem in developed nations. In fact, it is estimated that one in ten US residents has diabetes. Due to lockdowns and a lack of exercise, diabetes cases might have exploded without notice.

Heart disease is another problem. This refers to a large spectrum of diseases related to the heart. It is the top leading cause of death in the US. Globally, COVID-19 caused significant disruptions in heart disease testing. In the US, deaths from heart disease increased by 4.8 per cent in 2020. It was speculated that many diagnoses were missed due to concerns about COVID-19.

 Let's learn about them.

Cao Xueqin wrote *Dream of the Red Chamber* during the Qing dynasty. This story follows the rise and fall of a wealthy family in the capital. There are almost 40 major characters in the book, as well as hundreds of minor ones. The story is also somewhat based on the author's own life.

Journey to the West is one of the most famous stories in Chinese history. It is about a monk and his students' journey to get Buddhist scriptures from India. The story is famous for the many creatures and demons they meet along the way.

Romance of the Three Kingdoms is a historical novel that takes place during the decline of the Han dynasty and the rise of the Three Kingdoms. The story explores different themes like loyalty, victory and defeat. Nowadays, this story is often retold in TV series, comics and video games.

Finally, Water Margin is a story about 108 men who have no choice but to become outlaws under the rule of an unjust and tyrannical government. They gather at Mount Liang to form an army to fight foreign invaders and rebels.

The modern Olympic Games began in Athens, Greece in 1896. Fencing and swimming were some of the events that year. Women could not compete in the Olympics until 1900, however.

In the past, some of the events were quite different from how they are today. For example, in the shooting competition in 1900, athletes shot live pigeons. They killed nearly 300 pigeons in the event. Nowadays, athletes shoot clay targets.

The first Winter Olympic Games took place in 1924. Before that, events like figure skating and ice hockey were part of the Summer Olympic Games.
