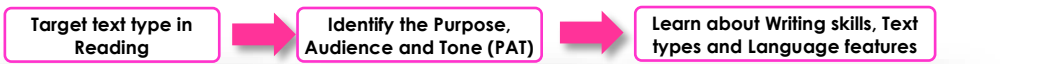

Elon Musk

Elon Musk is an influential entrepreneur, inventor and scientist. Driven by a desire for perfection, he has become one of the wealthiest people in the world. Elon, a natural leader, runs some of the world's most cutting-edge tech companies.

Elon's companies research and develop innovative products that are environmentally friendly and change the way we live. He is best known for founding SpaceX in 2002 and for becoming CEO of Tesla in 2008. In fact, Elon had already launched PayPal, the online payment giant, three years before SpaceX started. SpaceX makes space exploration more affordable by using self-driving, reusable rockets. Tesla is a leading manufacturer of practical and user-friendly electric cars.

Born in South Africa in 1971, Elon was a shy but creative child who was often bullied. He was passionate about computers and video games. At the age of 10, he created a space-themed game called Blastar. After studying Physics, he moved to the US aged 21.

Motivated by his dream of building a better future, Elon has been a hard-working and determined leader. His business philosophy can be best summed up as 'think big, start small and move fast'.

Writing skills Using the inverted pyramid method

The inverted pyramid method is a way to organize your text. We often use it to write news reports and biographies.

By putting the most important information at the beginning of the text, we can arouse interest and attract the reader's attention.

Most important information = Major achievements

Less important details = Noteworthy life events and interesting facts

Additional details

Language features See highlights about for the examples in this list.

Look at the following language items that we use in a biography. In pairs, try to find examples from Text 2 that match the functions of the language items.

Language item	Function
Simple present tense	to give facts about the person
Past tenses	to talk about actions and events that happened in the past
Recent past tense phrases	to give reasons or to show that two actions happen at a similar time
Past participle phrases	to show reasons for actions
Prepositions of time	to talk about when events happened and the order of events

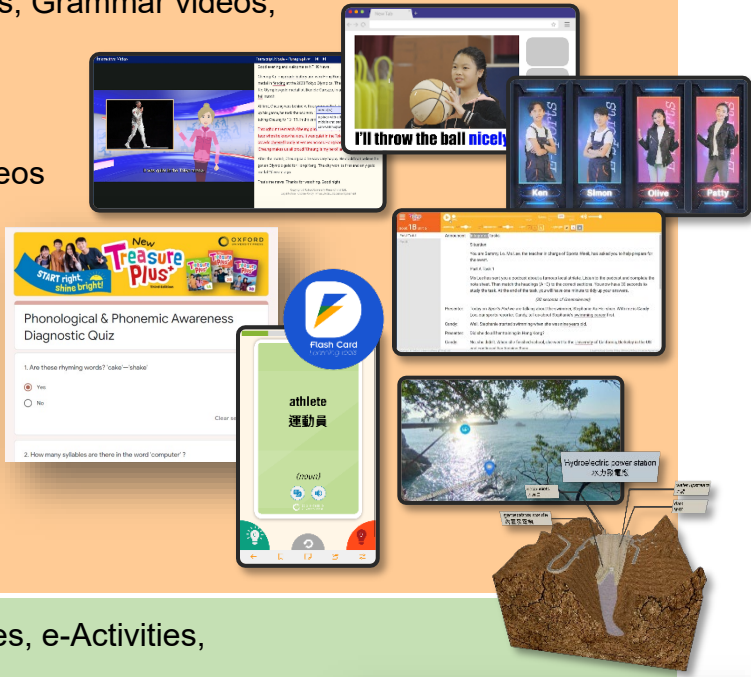
