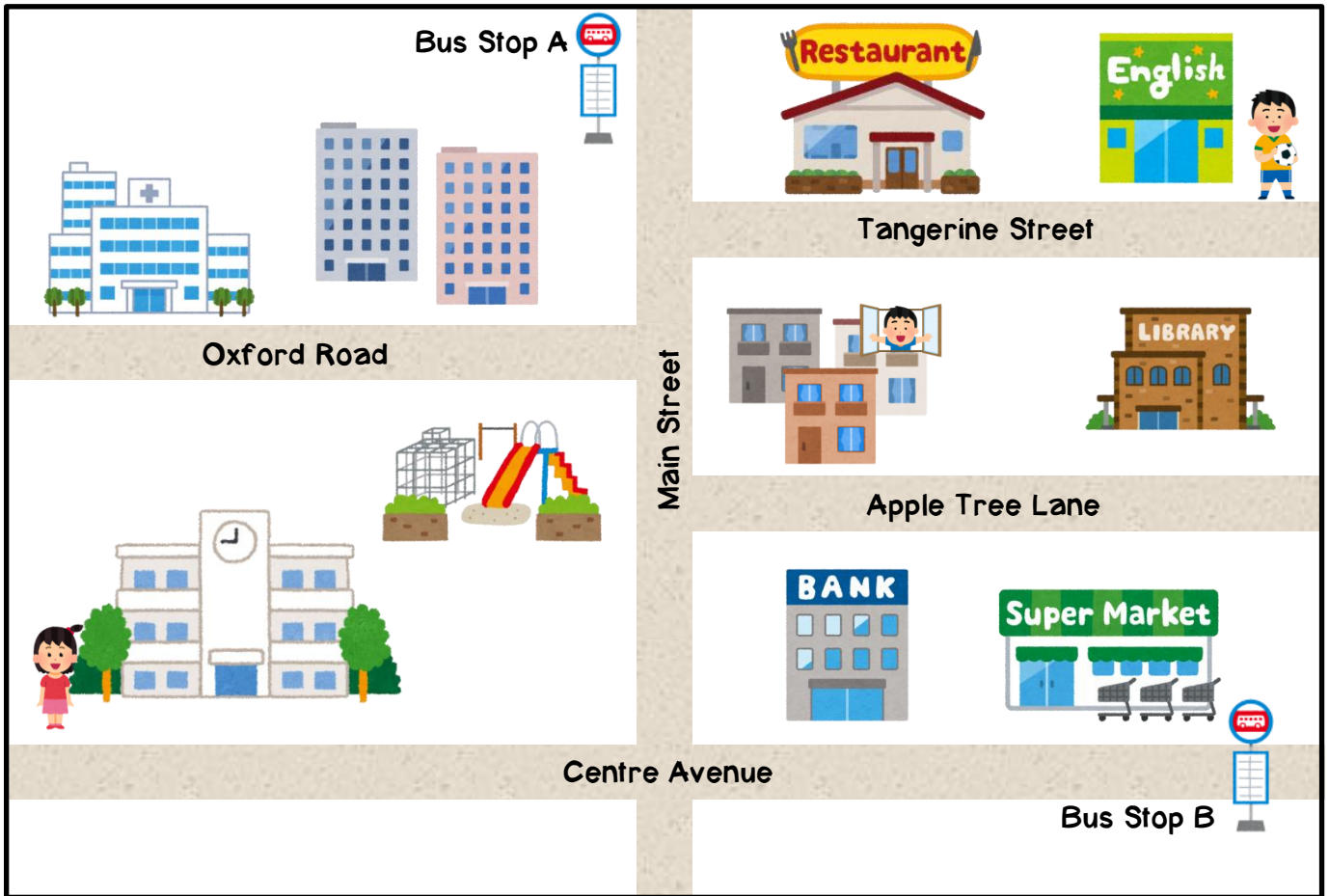

1. How can I get to the Library from Bus Stop A?

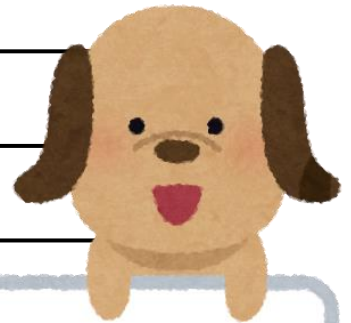
2. How can I get to the school from Bus Stop B?

 How can I get to...? (sample answers)
 1. Get onto Apple Tree Lane from the library, turn right and walk straight. Turn right on Main Street, Bus Stop A is on the left.
 2. Get onto Centre Avenue from the school. Turn left and follow along Centre Avenue, Bus Stop B is on the right.
 3. Get onto Centre Avenue from the school. Turn left and walk straight until you are on Main Street. Turn left on Main Street. Walk along Main Street past Apple Tree Lane. Turn right on Tangerine Street, pass the Restaurant. The Learning Centre is on the left.
